PROGRAM

It's always nice to have someone ready to pinch-hit when you're in a jam. We're lucky that our own **Paul Dodson** was available in his other incarnation as Commodore of the Coronado Yacht Club. CYC is such a big part of the fabric of our community and Paul was kind enough to tell us what's going on down there as it relates to the major remodel that going to take place. Paul is a 1958 graduate of Coronado High School, fifty years, how about that? He recently retired from the Coronado Police Department and was thankful that the Club bought the speaker's lunch. He was disappointed to discover that there were no donuts, however. Coronado Yacht Club was originally founded in 1913, but languished and died during WWI. It was reformed in 1932 and has been going strong ever since. The current fifty-year lease was signed in 1961 and USC math correctly notes that it will expire or need to be renewed in 2011. So, lots is going on including plans to build a new 15,000 square foot, single story clubhouse, add 108 wet slips, and rearrange the parking lot and entrance. Currently, CYC has 650 Flag members and 950 total members counting all the juniors and special categories. CYC is a community resource used by civic groups, junior sailors, and just about anyone else that wants to take advantage of one of the prettiest spots on San Diego Bay.
