Dan Gensler, Suzanne Popp, Mary Griffin , and **Tim Cusick** joined forces to tell us about their trip to South Africa to visit Sister Ethyl and Missionvale Care Centre. Our Club has completed one matching grant project with Missionvale and has two more in the works. Sister Ethyl and her care center serve over 100,000 township residents 80% of whom are unemployed and 60% of whom have HIV/AIDS. One of our pending matching grants is for a nutrition project (**Tim Cusick's** Tootsie Rolls don't count) and **Past President Dan** was able to announce that a \$50,000 grant (matched to \$100,000) has just been approved for a medical supplies project. **PP Dan** took the opportunity to introduce Charlie Reed, a Torrey Pines High School student, and Danielle Martin of his office. Charlie put together an event which raised \$1775 for Missionvale and Danielle won, beating **Mike Privett** by the way, an LPL Convention 5K run and donated her \$1500 prize to Missionvale.
