Today marked the annual visit from our District Governor. This year we had the honor of greeting DG Marge Cole, an educator by profession via the Santee/Lakeside Rotary Club. She shared with us her Rotary journey and how it tied into this year's International Theme which is "The Future of Rotary is in Your Hands." She told us of her trips to Kenya for a water well project, to Ecuador to provide a "mechanical cow" for a school, to India for National Immunization Day, and leading GSE trips to Mexico. We were also reminded that Bill Gates has donated \$255 million for polio eradication (thereby earning 255,000 Paul Harris Fellowships!) to be matched by \$100 million raised by Rotary.
