PROGRAM

We had our neighbor in for a visit today. **Steve Duermeyer** introduced RADM (ret) Mac McLaughlin who is the director of the USS Midway Museum. Besides announcing that our own **Ed Martin** will join the Midway's board of directors Mac reviewed the struggle to get the Midway to San Diego and, now that it's such a roaring success, where they go from here. USS Midway is already the most visited historical ship in the world. He shared some interesting statistics that seven of ten visitors to USS Midway have no connection to military service and nine of ten have no connection to the US Navy. The visitors come to tour a ship, not see a museum. USS Midway sees its future as a force in education and currently serves 50,000 San Diego students per year with a curriculum geared to patriotism and service.
