ISF supports much of the high school sports budget and ALL of the middle school sports budget. Since 2003 the state of California has eliminated funding for all middle school sports programs and the ISF has stepped up, big time! The ISF pays for almost everything in HS sports except for the coaches. John pointed out that 60% of all CHS students play in one of the 22 varsity sports and 25% of those play multiple sports. The ISF hopes to become what the CSF has become in support for the Coronado Schools.
