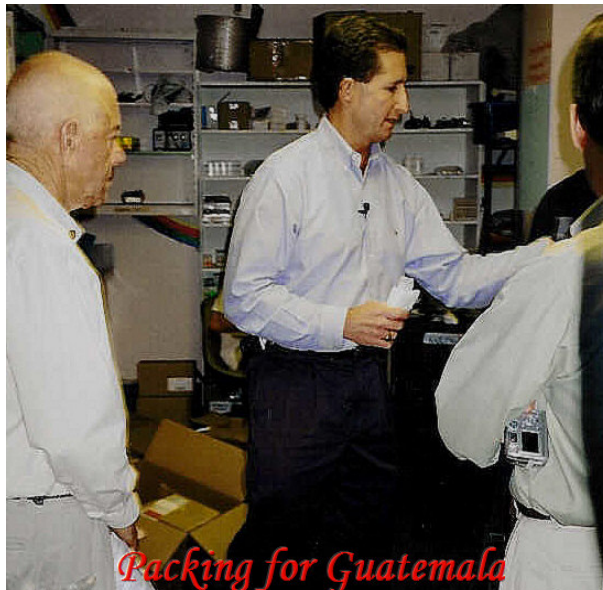
- A. The Rotary Haberdashery is open! Get your Rotary wear in time for Pancake Breakfast. Contact **Gloria LeBlanc** to place your order.
