PROGRAM:

Ken MacLeod introduced our own **Dan Layton** who brought us up to speed on the worldwide problem of landmines. Dan is a retired Army colonel who served Vietnam and Desert Storm and now works in the State Department's Office of Weapons Removal and Abatement. A few facts: There are 800,000 tons of abandoned ordinance in Iraq alone. Landmines kill about 20,000 people a year worldwide. Our Department of State currently has operations for the removal of unexploded ordinance in Laos, Angola, Rwanda, Afghanistan, Cambodia, Bosnia, Nicaragua, and, of course, Iraq. He also announced the formation of the Rotary Fellowship for Mine Action.
