In California, there are 478 cities, out of those; 112 that are charter cities. Chartering a city is sometimes referred to as implementing "home rule" The benefits of chartered cities for its citizens are as follows: 1. Reduce the cost of City government and save millions of dollars in the cost of public improvements. 2. Ensure that more local taxpayers' dollars would remain in the City. 3. Help defend the City against State-mandated programs that do not provide the necessary funding to implement those programs. A charter can only be adopted by a majority vote of city residents, not by city council
