We can all help a needy cause, drop off canned food at the community for the Boy Scouts to deliver to the Salvation army.

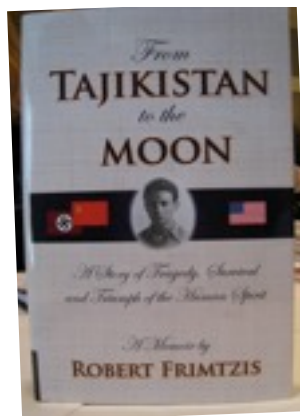
We have a well in Southern Sudan with our Rotary Club name on it. It was one of nine wells that have been drilled this year so far.
