Philippe Lamoise was born in Paris, France. That was the beginning of his international journey that brings him to Rotary District 5340 serving as District Governor 2006-2007.

Philippe's father was a Rotarian in France as is his brother currently. After completing his university education in France and serving in the French military, Philippe was hired by SAIC in 1992 and went to work in La Jolla.

When his father came to visit Philippe, he often did his Rotary make-up at the Torrey Pines La Jolla Rotary club, many times bringing Philippe along with him. When Philippe was recruited to join the Rotary Club of Torrey Pines La Jolla in 1994, he was the youngest member in the club. He is now the third youngest District Governor in the class of 2006-07, worldwide.

Philippe became involved in Rotary right away. He served as Club President in 1997-98. Since 2002 Philippe has been maintaining our District 5340 website and has developed many of the interactive tools that are so helpful to us today including online registration, online directory, district calendar, yellow pages, membership reports, Quickbits and much more. Philippe has also developed the interactive [Matching Grant website](#) that is being used by clubs and districts worldwide.

The real international story is Philippe's many Rotary trips. He has traveled twice to Malawi for Operation Malawi in 2001 and Wheelchairs for Malawi in 2003. He went twice to India as a Rotary Volunteer. He traveled to East Africa with our GSE team in April 2001 visiting Kenya, Ethiopia, Uganda and Tanzania. In addition he has made trips to Costa Rica, Mexico, Ghana, Ecuador & France for a Rotary purpose.

Philippe has served our district in many capacities in the past. He has been Inbound Ambassadorial Scholars Chair, Communications Chair, Matching Grant Chair, and Webmaster.

Philippe has been recognized by his club as Rotarian of the Year 2000-01. He has been recognized by the District as Rotarian of the Year 2001-02. In 2005 The Rotary Foundation recognized Philippe with the prestigious Citation for Meritorious Service.

Philippe became a citizen of the United States of America in 2004. Professionally Philippe is self employed developing websites and doing video productions. These professional skills are often used to serve Rotary. He travels with his video and still cameras to produce pictures and documentaries of the projects he visits.
